What Happened?

- 2 Sept 20 Code issued by UK's ICO
- 2 Sept 21 12-month transition period ends
- Statutory Code of Practice
- Translates GDPR requirements into 15 standards for online services
- Applies to:

"relevant information society services which are likely to be accessed by children"

non-UK companies who process the personal data of UK children
